Year 4	Developing singing techniques - singing songs in unison at the correct pitch and with increasing expression to perform at a live venue.	Body and tuned percussion - the sounds of the rainforest. The origins of Rock and Roll and learning to play the bassline.	Here come the Vikings - adapting and transposing motifs. Exploring Samba and carnival sounds, rhythms and instruments.
Year 5	Developing singing techniques - singing songs in unison with correct diction and at a controlled pitch to perform at a live venue.	Learn the Clarinet in whole class instrumental lessons	Use 'Incredibox' to loop and remix different tunes. History of the Blues and 12 bar Blues playing.
Year 6	Singing songs of World War II and notating a melody. Whole class instrumental lessons (P-Buzz development)	Understanding sounds and scores to compose film Music.
